Course Structure

MONEY 101 EDUCATION has five segments, each with five classes:

- FOUNDATION Budgeting, credit, and financial basics (Details)
- INVESTMENTS Stocks, bonds, and portfolio building (Details)
- TAXATION Understanding tax returns and deductions (Details)
- REAL ESTATE Buying, selling, and mortgage essentials (Details)
- MONEY & LIFE CYCLES Financial planning for every life stage (Details)

Many students return for multiple segments; a few have completed all five to become Money 101 Graduates!

Free Repeat Option

7. Be Ready to Introduce Yourself (1 Minute Max!)

Keep it to 1 minute, so we have time for everyone.

Example:

"I'm a retired businesswoman with three grown children. I love long-distance biking, skiing, and CrossFit. I've traveled the world and visited Mongolia in 2024. I created Money 101 to help people build wealth, and my greatest joy is hearing how my classes have changed lives—especially for women!"

8. Hold Off Booking a Private Session until after you have attended three classes.

Follow the GROUND RULES

- 1. Be on Time Join Zoom by 4:25 PM EST (5 min early). We start on time, and late arrivals are disruptive.

DIANE DREY - FUN AND CASUAL - BUSINESS BACKGROUND

At 12, my father woke me early, ready to impart wisdom. I expected philosophy—he gave me **typing, taxes, and accounting**!

He drilled me on typing before school, hired a CPA to teach me **double-entry bookkeeping**, and had me complete a business tax return. (At 12!) That early financial education set the foundation for my future.

In college, alongside my **art major**, I studied accounting, became an **IRS-trained Volunteer Income Tax Assistant (VITA)**, and found joy in a subject many fear. Afterward, I pursued an **MBA in Finance** and joined **SnowBird**, our family's bottled water company.

Starting from the ground up, I worked every role—including on the bottling line, taking customer service calls, fixing water coolers, selling to new accounts,

and collecting money from clients who "forgot" to pay their bills. When my father **passed unexpectedly in 1989,** I took over **managing 140 employees**. I was 33 years old!

During my career, I have tackled countless challenges—**rebranding and changing the company name**, negotiating with unions, surviving recessions, and adapting as big-box stores disrupted our industry by selling water coolers, which caused customers to stop renting them from us. As rental revenue declined, I pivoted, adding **coffee and office refreshments** to stay competitive.

It was a 32-year journey with many ups and more than my share of "downs." I had many "learning experiences," so today, I often say, "I have been there and done that."





Making a real estate purchase takes a lot of legwork – I looked at 46 buildings and 23 pieces of land before I fell in love with this site in Jersey City

In 2000, I tackled a major challenge: **relocating our company** from a six-story Manhattan loft to New Jersey.

I found the perfect abandoned warehouse after touring **46 buildings and 23 land parcels**. I secured financing, **rehabilitated the site**, and built a new bottling plant.

I love construction, and this gut renovation of a 66,000 sq. ft building was a year effort – We had 800 people at our opening party,

By 2001, we were fully operational—**just across the Hudson River from Manhattan**, where we witnessed 9/11 firsthand.

Our strategic location was a key reason Nestlé acquired my company in 2008, allowing me to retire at 52.



After retiring, I began a new journey, joining SCORE as a volunteer in the New York City chapter. Score provides FREE mentoring to entrepreneurs, and since 2008, I have mentored over 1,000 aspiring and in-business entrepreneurs, providing guidance to help them grow and succeed.



From 2014 to 2016, I served as the Chair of SCORE's New York City Chapter. I founded the NYC Business Owner Roundtable and Advisory

Board Service during my tenure, a program now run by other SCORE mentors. This initiative continues to support business owners with valuable peer-to-peer mentorship.

My latest volunteer project for SCORE is *Money 101 Education*, a comprehensive financial literacy program designed to empower women with the knowledge and confidence to manage their finances.



Money 101 Education consists of five segments, each with five two-hour classes: Foundation, Investments, Taxation, Real Estate, and Money & Life Cycles. Since its inception in 2019, over 440 people have participated in at least one segment of the program.

The most rewarding part of this journey has been hearing from participants who tell me the program has changed their lives and helped them "take the fear out of finance."
